"To educate the best business developers in the world"

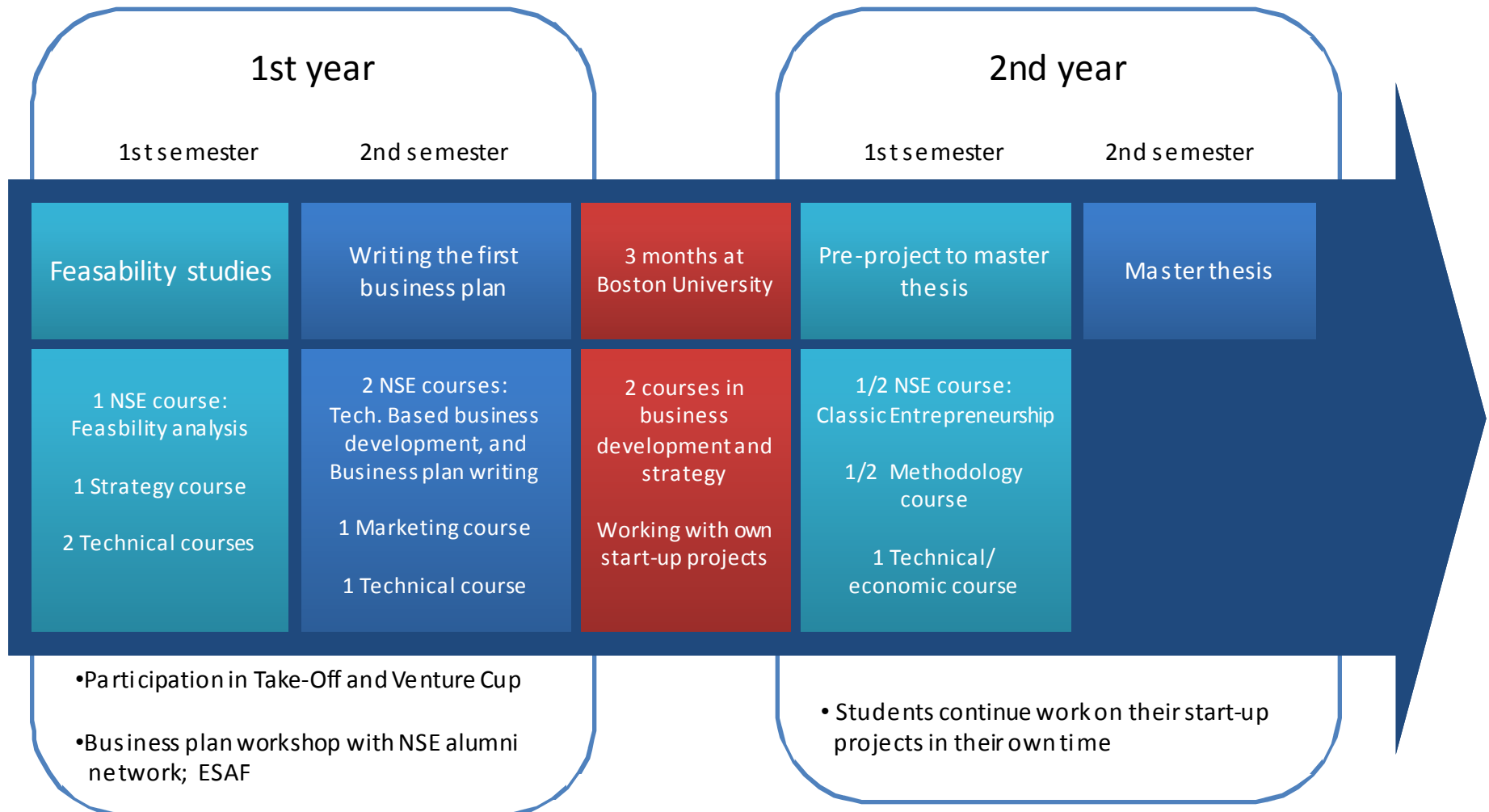


History
