



WHAT IS LUMINK?

LuMiNK Academy is a collaboration between Linköping University (LiU), Mirum shopping mall and Norrköping municipality. The name is a pun of the three players.

In the pilot project, which started in August 2015, 20 students from a secondary school "Söderporten" regularly meet 13 students from different programs at Linköping University in order to be inspired in their further studies.

The project has drawn inspiration and experience from similar projects, including "Line 14" in Örebro and "Goda grannar" in Ryd.

WHY HAS IT LAUNCHED?

Norrköping municipality are working on ways to raise the level of education in Norrköping and wish that this project will complete the work in a positive way.

Linköping University has a continuing interest in attracting future students, preferably with different cultural backgrounds and welcomes the recruitment addition can be made locally.

Mirum shoppingcenter has long been involved in efforts to develop the district Hageby in different ways, they want to take social responsibility and try to create a natural meeting place between academia and society.

In view of the above interests have LuMiNK Academy started with the hope of getting more schools, pupils and students in Norrköping into part of a continued long-term cooperation.

HOW IT IS FUNDED?

The pilot project is funded by Lyskraft which is a collaboration between the Municipality of Norrköping and Linköping University, which aims to create arenas for cooperation between the two parties.
