# Norrköping R&D fund

The Executive City Council of Norrköping decided 2012, to establish a R&D fund for supporting a long-term development of Norrköping.

20 million SEK (2,1 million EUR)

It became evident, right after the first call for applications in 2012, that this was "appreciated".

Subsequently, another 14 millions has been added.

# The objectives for the Fund

- Raising the educational level of the inhabitants of the Municipality of Norrköping
- Renewing and developing municipal activities
- To strengthen education and research at Linköping University - Campus Norrköping
- To develop the city of Norrköping

# How?

- Review panel – of 9 persons
- Assessment criteria
- Supplementary interviews, if necessary
- The municipal executive board decides
- Team of researchers that follow up the aims of the fund
- Projects have to report yearly and a final report after the end of the project
- Every second year – Show-Case-Event

# Results so far after 6 calls

- 149 applications (72 women and 79 men)
- Total sum of applications 241 millions SEK
- 28 applications have been granted money
- Variation of granted money from 0,250 to 3,0 million SEK- 16 over 1 million

- Approx 28 millions SEK have been allocated
- Money attracts money - research 40-50 million SEK
- Project runs from one semester to 4 years

# Projects examples

- Recreation homes in the future
- Reconfigurable Radio and Radar Plattform
- Smart City-Internet of Things
- Loneliness among the elderly as a social problem
- Open Campus
- Simulation and modeling of ion electronics
- Demonstrator: 3D visualization Ostlänken
- Online gambling habits of young
